Application Requirements

- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- Applicants must include a minimum of two letters of recommendation from an individual who can attest to applicants involvement. (may be from their own board or another chapter)
- The "unofficial" transcript of grades must be attached to the application.

Essay

Applicants must submit a well-developed, typed essay on their involvement in ULSA. The essay should be one to two pages in length and should follow the MLA style.

Instructions for Submission

All materials submitted with the application become the property of the United Latino Students Association and will not be returned to applicants.

The completed application and related documents must be submitted to the ULSA board at uls.ulspresident@gmail.com or mailed to 7845 Phlox St. Downey CA, 90241. Incomplete applications and applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

ULSA INVOLVEMENT ESSAY GUIDELINES AND RUBRIC

In a well-developed essay, please address the following questions:

- How were you involved within your own chapter?
- What events did you attend through ULSA?
- Through your involvement within ULSA what have you gained that will help contribute to the success of your future career?

Please also keep in mind the following criteria:

- Please include the title of the prompt in the middle of the top header and full name on the right of the top header.
- The essay must be typed (double-spaced) in Times New Roman (font size 12).
- The essay must be one to two pages in length and must be written using MLA style.
